### **Careers Education**

Careers education is delivered in mentoring sessions as well as in faculties through lessons. We have a dedicated careers week, where each faculty will explore career links to their subjects and help students recognise the number of careers that are available linked to this subject. Students will also learn about the different career paths available and how to access these.

### **Personal Guidance**

Students receive personal guidance from individual appointments with our independent Careers Adviser. As well as scheduled appointments there is a weekly drop-in session for Sixth Formers so careers guidance is easily accessible. All careers sessions are followed up by an action plan which students can follow.

As you may well be aware each student will also have an individual mentor. This mentor will lead mentoring sessions but also have one-to-one meetings with students. The mentor can support the student to reach their next step, this can include exploring university options, helping with personal statements and applying for apprenticeships.

### **Engagement with Employers**

In Year 12 we support students in organising work experience in an area of interest to them.

Throughout the year we organise talks from different employers and organisations that students are invited to attend.

We feature different alumni, employers and employees during careers week, during lessons and in mentoring. This allows students to have a wide range of employer engagement as well as a chance to learn about a range of job roles and different career paths.

Students also have access to Unifrog. This programme allows them to access excellent career advice, career tools and to record their career journey. It also offers a vast amount of information about university courses and apprenticeships and support with writing personal statements and Curriculum Vitae.
